

## Gettysburg Elementary General Information for 2022-2023

### Mission/Vision

The elementary program is designed to provide a fun learning environment for younger wrestlers teaching them the essential basics and exposing them to some higher level wrestling. An emphasis must be placed upon effort, learning, advancement of skill, promotion of healthy active kids, good sportsmanship and team concepts, promotion of Gettysburg Wrestling and the Gettysburg community, and being successful at the next level (National Champions, State Champions, All Americans, etc.).

**Eligibility-** The Gettysburg Elementary Program is designed for students in Gettysburg School District grades K-6

**Registration Cost-**\$15.00 per student. This cost will provide students with a shirt, short, and covers insurance

**Singlet Deposit-**\$35.00 per student. Singlets are worn for competitions. If not competing you do not need a singlet. Singlets must be returned at the end of the season in order to receive your deposit.

Students being placed into groups will be determined after registration. Younger experienced students may be moved to Group 2 and older inexperienced students may be moved to Group 1.

We do not push students to participate in many competitions. Our competition schedule will be limited. We will discuss in detail at our parent meeting our plans for competitions. Families are free to attend competitions on their own if they desire.
